Disgraced Police Chief Blames Milwaukee's Murders on "Weak" Gun Laws - NRA/ILA - Friday, July 10, 2015

On July 10, USA Today reported that Milwaukee Police Chief Edward Flynn is blaming what he calls Wisconsin's "absurdly weak" gun control laws for an increase in murders in Milwaukee during the first half of 2015. [View Related Articles](#)

The newspaper noted, "Milwaukee has had 84 murders this year, more than double the 41 it tallied at the same point last year." However, it also noted that Baltimore and Chicago, which have restrictive gun control laws, and New Orleans and St. Louis, which have less restrictive laws, have also experienced increases in murder. And Los Angeles and San Diego, which have California's restrictive laws, and Phoenix and Indianapolis, which have less restrictive laws, have experienced decreases in murder. Although Flynn should be aware of such facts, he's just one of those guys that doesn't know when to stop letting his bias against guns get the better of him.

In 2013, during Sen. Dianne Feinstein's (D-Calif.) Senate hearings on her legislation to ban all semi-automatic shotguns and all detachable-magazine semi-automatic rifles as "assault weapons," Flynn disgraced himself and undermined Feinstein's effort during a heated exchange with Sen. Lindsay Graham (R-S.C.). Soon thereafter, on MSNBC, Flynn complained about the ownership of "high quality, high-capacity semi-automatic handguns" and said that it was "fundamental" that "the rights of communities ... are every bit as important as the rights of individuals." Sounds like Flynn would be more at ease having dinner with Vladimir Lenin than Thomas Jefferson.

Last year, in a vote held by Milwaukee's police union, 99 percent of officers who cast ballots not surprisingly said they had "no confidence" in Flynn.

Wisconsin/Nevada: Expanded List of Recognized Concealed-Carry Permits - NRA/ILA - June 19, 2015



Wisconsin FORCE Applauds Governor Walker for Signing the Bill Removing Unnecessary and Dangerous 48-Hour Waiting Period

Wisconsin FORCE applauds Governor Walker for signing into law Senate Bill 35. The bill eliminates the unnecessary and dangerous 48-hour waiting period on handgun purchases, reducing the burdens placed on victims of violence, small businesses, and law-abiding Wisconsinites.

It is now lawful for consumers purchasing a handgun from a licensed firearm dealer, to take the gun home once the dealer receives notice from the Department of Justice that the background check indicates they aren't prohibited from possessing a firearm. Purchasing and taking home both rifles and shotguns has been done this way for many years.

The 48-Hour rule for handgun purchases was first enacted in Wisconsin in 1976. Due to the advent of instant background checks, such as the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS), the 48 hour waiting period had become an unnecessary burden for both the consumer and the dealer.

Waiting 48 hours could mean life or death for otherwise defenseless people. Those intent on doing evil always find a way. Abusers tend to be bigger and stronger than their victims who should be allowed to level the playing field. Wisconsin FORCE thanks Governor Walker, Senator Wanggaard, Representative Quinn, and the bill's [co-sponsors](#) for their work on removing this unnecessary and dangerous waiting period.

Another Gun Control Claim Bites the Dust - NRA/ILA July 01, 2015

If it sounds like we're repeating ourselves, it's because we are. For the proverbial umpteenth time, Fact Checkers at a prominent newspaper have denounced a lie being told by a supporter of expanded background checks on gun sales.

On Monday, the *Washington Post* gave [Four Pinnochios](#) to U.S. Sen. Chris Murphy (D-Conn.) for repeating a [claim](#) originated by Michael Bloomberg's Everytown for Gun Safety group, that there has been an average of one school shooting per week since the December 2012 crime at Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, Connecticut.

"Applying a reasonable person standard" to what should be considered a "school shooting" in the context of the Sandy Hook crime, the *Post* concluded that of 126 incidents on Everytown's list, most were suicides or attempted suicides, accidents, or shootings resulting from arguments between individuals, and perhaps only 10 were crimes in which someone intended to shoot multiple people.

The *Post*, saying "lawmakers need to present information—especially for such a controversial topic as gun control—in a clear, responsible and accurate way," considered Sen. Murphy's lie particularly egregious in view of the fact that Everytown's claims about school shootings have been so widely discredited previously. As examples, the *Atlanta Journal-Constitution* first rated Everytown's claims about the number of school shootings since Sandy Hook [mostly false](#) back in June 2014. Three months later, John Lott released the result of [research](#) that found that some of the persons involved in the incidents cited by Everytown weren't even associated with the schools and/or the incidents didn't occur during regular school hours.

The *Washington Post* gave [Four Pinnochios](#) to U.S. Sen. Chris Murphy (D-Conn.) for repeating a [claim](#) originated by Michael Bloomberg's Everytown for Gun Safety group.

Maybe Murphy can take comfort from the fact that he's not the only anti-gunner that has been taken to task for telling lies. In 2013, the *Post* [rejected](#) former Pres. Bill Clinton's claim that half of all mass killings in the United States had occurred since the September 2004 expiration of his "ban" on "assault weapons" and "large" magazines. The newspaper said, "the available data show that Clinton was way off base in his assertion, making an exaggerated claim—which his office would not even defend."

The same year, the *Post* gave Pres. Barack Obama [Three Pinnochios](#) for repeating Everytown's claim that 40 percent of firearms are sold without a background check. (And even if Obama had been telling the truth, it would only have been an endorsement for checkless firearm sales, given that the nation's murder rate is at or near an all-time low.)

In December, the *Journal-Constitution* gave a [mostly false](#) rating to Everytown's claim exaggerating school shootings in Georgia. In March, the *Post* gave Pres. Barack Obama [Three Pinnochios](#) for his "odd series of exaggerated gun claims," including the claim that the U.S. has the world's highest murder rate, the claim that it's easier to buy a handgun than a vegetable, and the claim that gun control opponents want laws to allow "firearms in kindergartens and machine guns in bars."

In April, the *Richmond Times-Dispatch* gave a [mostly false](#) rating to Sen. Tim Kaine (D-Va.) for repeating the "40 percent" claim that Pres. Obama was faulted for previously, but which Everytown [continues to use](#) every chance it gets. Also in April, Everytown was caught trying to [exaggerate](#) the size of their miniscule anti-gun demonstration during the NRA Annual Meeting in Nashville.

In May, the *Journal-Constitution* rated as ["mostly false"](#) Everytown's claim that weak gun laws were responsible for a gun being stolen in Georgia and later used in a crime in New York City.

And last week, the *Tampa Bay Tribune* rated as [mostly false](#) Obama's recent claim comparing multiple victim shootings in the U.S. to those in other countries.

But when have the facts had any bearing on what gun control supporters say?

What to Do When Your Doctor Asks About Your Guns - *Timothy Wheeler, MD is director of Doctors for Responsible Gun Ownership Second Amendment Foundation - [June 27, 2015](#) by [DRGO](#)*



Have you had the experience of going to your doctor for a particular problem, let's say headaches, and been surprised by the doctor asking you about a completely unrelated subject—whether you have a gun in your home? It's no accident that doctors' or health plans' questions about guns in your home have become routine. In the 1980s and 1990s medical professional organizations declared a culture war on gun ownership in America. The American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) developed an official policy ([2012 version here](#)) urging pediatricians to probe their young patients' parents about guns in their homes.

Claiming only to be concerned about "gun safety", the latest code term for gun control, the AAP pushed its member doctors to advise families to get rid of their guns. One of the authors of the original AAP anti-gun policy, Dr. Katherine Christoffel, was [quoted in an AMA journal](#) as saying "Guns are a virus that must be eradicated."

The American Medical Association (AMA) and the [American College of Physicians](#) (ACP) have also mounted aggressive and highly publicized campaigns against gun ownership and advised their member physicians to pressure their patients to get rid of their guns. Other physician specialty groups have done the same.

Many people are rightly outraged by this unprofessional behavior of some physicians. Several states, most notably Florida, have passed laws to stop doctors and other health care professionals from misusing their patients' trust to push a political agenda of gun control. Such abuse of authority and trust by a physician is called an ethical [boundary violation](#).

You may encounter the question in your health plan's standard health appraisal questionnaire. Even though it may not be of your doctor's making, it's still part of your permanent medical record. Or your doctor may have a personal prejudice against gun ownership, shaped by her training in medical school or residency. Either way, it is important for people to know some very important facts:

- Doctors receive absolutely no training about firearm safety, mechanics, or tactics in medical school or residency. They are completely unqualified by their training to advise anyone about guns.
- Gun ownership is a civil right. A doctor's abuse of his position of trust to pressure you to give up that civil right is professionally and morally wrong. In some states it is illegal. You DO NOT have to tolerate it.
- You as a consumer have great power in the doctor-patient relationship. Do not be afraid to use it.

Let's be clear. We're not talking about a doctor who casually talks with you about guns out of a common interest you both may have. If you and your doc get to comparing notes about your favorite hunting rifles or latest trip to the gun range, that is a world apart from a calculated effort to prejudice you against gun ownership.

So what can you do when your doctor or your health plan starts asking you about guns in your home? Your doctor may very likely just be going along with the guidelines of his or her gun-hating medical organization, such as the AAP or ACP. One survey showed that although many doctors agree that guns are a public health problem, [only a minority](#) feel it's right to ask their patients about guns in their homes. Many doctors sense that it's wrong and don't allow themselves to be recruited as gun control activists by their medical organizations. A range of options is available to you, some sending a more powerful message than others. These are updated from DRGO's [original recommendations](#), since the medical profession has changed so much in the last two decades.

- 1) Politely refuse to answer the doctor's question or the health plan's questionnaire item about guns. You can either explain your discomfort with the question or decline to give a reason.
- 2) If the gun question(s) appears on your health plan's routine health assessment questionnaire, file a formal written complaint with the health plan. Every health plan has a member complaint process, often prescribed by law. Your complaint will be registered and the health plan will respond.
- 3) If the health plan responds with the excuse that their questions about your guns are standard medical practice that they must follow, you can take the complaint to the next step—file a written complaint with your state agency that regulates health plans. For example, in California you would follow the complaint procedure on the [Department of Managed Health Care](#) web site. It's your right as a patient under California law.
- 4) If your doctor persists in asking intrusive questions about guns in your home, you can also file a complaint specifically against him or her with your health plan. Such complaints are taken seriously, and the doctor will be called to account for it. Having one or more complaints about ethical boundary violations on her record will make her think twice about doing it again.
- 5) Internet consumer rating sites have created another way doctors can be publicly rated on the basis of service, attitude, and behavior. Some commonly used rating sites are [Yelp.com](#), [Healthgrades.com](#), [Vitals.com](#), and [RateMDs](#).
- 6) Increasingly, doctors' pay from Medicare and insurance companies is tied to how they score on patient satisfaction surveys. These are often sent randomly to patients, but you can request one to fill out. You can have a powerful impact on a doctor's conduct by reporting the doctor's unethical questioning about your guns.
- 7) If the doctor's conduct is especially offensive, as was the case with [this Florida pediatrician](#), you have the right to submit a complaint to the doctor's licensing board. This is an agency in your state government that holds the ultimate power of licensure over your doctor. A quick internet search for "medical board" in your state should take you to the official form for filing a complaint. This is a step that should not be taken lightly.continued on next page.....

Remember when writing your complaint to be polite. Explain why you find the doctor's or health plan's behavior unacceptable. Include the powerful points we've discussed:

- Your doctor is professionally unqualified to give expert advice on firearms
- Your right to own firearms is a civil right that is none of your doctor's business
- A doctor misusing his or her authority and trust to push a political agenda of gun control is an ethical *boundary violation*. Such unprofessional conduct is not acceptable.

Your right to own a firearm is enshrined in the Constitution. Don't let any doctor or health plan intimidate you into giving up your civil rights. Download the DRGO Resource Document "What to Do When Your Doctor Asks About Your Guns" [here](#)

US Army Considering Switch to Hollow Point Ammunition – OutdoorHub- Daniel Xu - 7/9/15

Will the next Army sidearm come with hollow point ammunition?

A [press release](#) sent out yesterday by Program Executive Office (PEO) Soldier, the organization responsible for the prototyping, procurement, and fielding of equipment for the US military, stated that the Army will be considering new ammunition types beyond full metal jacket—including expanding and fragmenting ammunition.

The announcement was made by a representative of the Army Judge Advocate General's Office at an industry event related to the Army's ongoing search for a new sidearm to replace the current M9. With more than 20 companies in attendance—and vying for the coveted contract for the Army's new XM-17 Modular Handgun System—the bombshell dropped: the Army was considering jacketed hollow point ammunition.

"Expanding the XM-17 Modular Handgun competition to include special purpose ammunition will provide the Warfighter with a more accurate and lethal handgun," said Richard Jackson, special assistant to the Army Judge Advocate General's Office and an expert on wartime law. But are hollow points legal for military use? That was the question that many industry observers asked after the announcement. Contrary to popular belief, the United States was never a signatory to the 1899 Hague Conventions article section that outlawed so-called "dum dum" bullets, or expanding ammunition. Furthermore, that specific section of Article IV that concerns the use of expanding bullets only applies to wars between signatory powers, which is not likely to occur anytime soon. The United States was the only major power at the time to decline signing the article.

Jackson further argued that even in signatory nations, hollow point ammunition is still used by law enforcement agencies due to its effectiveness and for the "increased capability it provides against threats."

The Army has also already fielded hollow point ammunition before, although infrequently and usually only to snipers. With the search for a new combat pistol, the Army is now considering a much wider roll out.

"Other types of ammunition allow the XM-17 Modular Handgun System to be optimized by vendors, providing a more capable system to Warfighters across the spectrum of shooter experience and skill level," Jackson stated.

That said, the Army has yet to indicate what caliber it will ultimately settle on, although it does seek an improvement over the M882, the 9x19mm NATO 124-grain FMJ currently in service.

The contract for the XM-17 Modular Handgun will only go to one manufacturer, but the Army has not detailed how ammunition will be procured.
